





Windowing Fusible Appliqué

Choose a lightweight "sewable" fusible product. The staff at your favorite quilt shop can recommend brands. Always read and follow manufacturer's instructions for proper fusing time and iron temperature.

- **1.** Trace appliqué motifs onto paper side of fusible web, making a separate tracing for each appliqué needed (*Photo A*).
- **2.** Roughly cut out drawn appliqué shapes, cutting about ¼" outside drawn lines (*Photo B*).
- **3.** "Window" fusible by trimming out the interior of the shape, leaving a scant ¼" inside drawn line (*Photo C*). Follow
- manufacturer's instructions to fuse web side of each shape to wrong side of appliqué fabric.
- **4.** Cut out appliqués, cutting carefully on drawn outline (*Photo D*). Only a thin band of fusible web frames the shape.
- **5.** Peel off paper backing (*Photo E*). Position appliqué in place on background fabric, and follow manufacturer's instructions to fuse shapes in place (*Photo F*).

If you have trouble peeling off the paper backing, try scoring paper with a pin to give you an edge to begin with. —Marianne
