# Chickadees Mini Quilt

Designed & Machine Quilted by  
**Carol Hanson**

Finished Quilt Size  
**18½" x 19½"**

Number of Blocks & Finished Size  
**20 Log Cabin Blocks 3" x 3"**

### Plan

Carol's clever design takes full advantage of the sweet Chickadees & Berries panel and coordinating prints, designed by Jackie Robinson for Benartex. This darling mini quilt incorporates scenes from the panel print not used in the larger wall quilt.

### Shop

Cream/tan print (piecing)	1 fat eighth*
Cream/red print (blocks)	1 fat eighth*
Cream/gold print (blocks)	1 fat eighth*
Red/gold swirl print (blocks)	1 fat quarter**
Gold swirl print (blocks, sashing)	1 fat quarter**
Red/gold print (blocks, binding)	½ yd.
Chickadees panel (rectangles)	1 panel***
Backing and batting	22" x 22" piece each

\*A fat eighth is 9" x 20-22".

\*\*A fat quarter is 18" x 20-22".

\*\*\*The panel is approximately 23" x 44".

### Cut

#### (in order listed)

Cream/tan print	1 strip 1" x 20-22"
	2 strips 1½" x 6½"
Cream/red print	1 strip 1" x 20-22"
	20 rectangles 1" x 1½"

Cream/gold print	20 rectangles 1" x 2"
	20 rectangles 1" x 1½"
Red/gold swirl print	20 strips 1" x 2½"
	20 rectangles 1" x 2"
Gold swirl print	1 strip 1½" x 18½"
	20 rectangles 1" x 3"
	20 strips 1" x 2½"
Red/gold print	3 strips 2½" x width of fabric (binding)
	20 strips 1" x 3½"
	20 strips 1" x 3"
*Chickadees panel	2 rectangles 6½" x 11½"

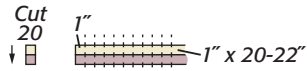




**Cutting Diagram**

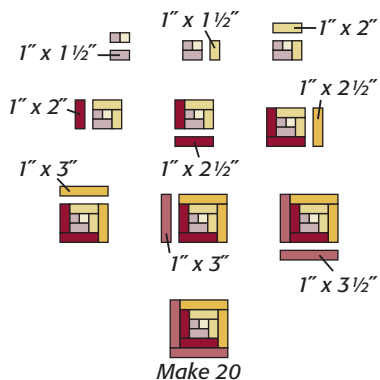
## Sew

- 1 Sew together 1 each cream/tan print and cream/red print 20-22" strips to make strip set (Diagram I). Press in direction of arrow. Cut into 20 segments 1" wide.

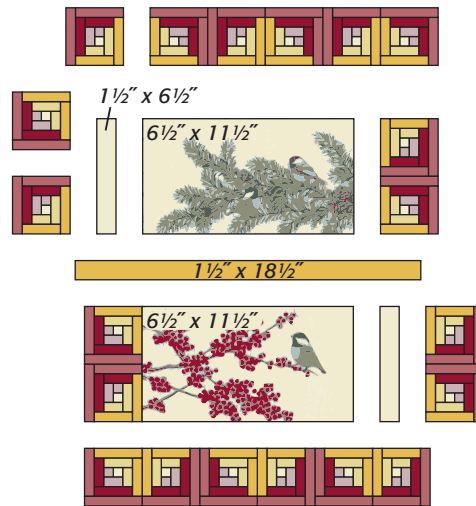
- 2 Referring to Diagram II and watching orientation of segment, sew cream/red 1" x 1 1/2" rectangle to bottom of segment. Stitch cream/gold print 1" x 1 1/2" rectangle to right side and cream/gold 1" x 2" rectangle to top. In similar manner and working counterclockwise, add remaining strips in sizes and fabrics indicated to make Log Cabin Block. Make 20.

- 3 Refer to Assembly Diagram for following steps, watching placement and orientation. Sew 2 top/bottom rows using 6 Log Cabin Blocks each.
- 4 Sew cream/tan 6 1/2" strip to 1 end of chickadee panel 6 1/2" x 11 1/2" rectangle to make unit. Join 2 Log Cabin Blocks; make 2 and sew to ends of unit to complete chickadee row. Make 2 total.

- 5 Join rows and gold swirl print 18 1/2" strip as shown.
- 6 Layer, baste, and quilt. Using threads to match the fabrics, Carol machine echo quilted around the figures in the chickadee print rectangles and quilted swirls in the blocks and center gold strip. Bind with red/gold print.
