

Web Bonus:

Based a Quilt Designed by Pamela Lincoln

Finished Quilt Size 29" x 32"

Note: Appliqué templates at end of pattern are printed reversed and without seam allowance to use with paper-backed fusible web.

This stylish wall hanging was inspired by an acrylic painting by Donna Mibus (etsy.com/shop/donnamibus). Use the assorted orange Halloween prints to make a spooky, scrappy background for the black kitty! Use solid orange for the small appliqué accents so they really pop.

Shop

Orange dot (piecing, border, binding) 1 yd. 8 assorted orange prints/ solids/textures (piecing, 1 fat eighth* appliqué) each Black solid (piecing, appliqué) 3/4 yd. Paper-backed fusible web 7/8 yd. Backing 11/8 yds. Batting size 36" x 38" *A fat eighth is a 9" x 20-22" cut of fabric.

Cut

(in order listed, before cutting appliqué)

Note: Cutting instructions for appliqué shapes are on templates at end of pattern. Orange dot

- 4 strips 21/2" x width of fabric (WOF) for binding
- *4 strips 21/4" x 34"
- 2 rectangles 41/2" x 51/2"
- 2 rectangles 21/2" x 41/2"
- 4 strips 11/2" x 51/2"
- 10 strips 11/2" x 41/2"
- 4 strips 11/2" x 31/2"
- 6 rectangles 11/2" x 21/2"
- 4 squares 11/2" x 11/2"

8 assorted orange prints/solids/texturescut a total of:

- 8 rectangles 41/2" x 51/2"
- 10 rectangles 31/2" x 41/2"
- 13 rectangles 21/2" x 41/2"

Black solid

8 strips 1" x 251/2"

12 strips 1" x 51/2"

12 strips 1" x 31/2"

18 strips 1" x 21/2"

12 rectangles 1" x 11/2"

*Border strips include extra length for trim-

1 Referring to **Diagram I**, sew together 2 orange dot 11/2" squares, 6 black solid 1" x 11/2" rectangles, and 5 orange dot 11/2" x 41/2" strips as shown to make row A. Make 2. Make rows B-D in fabrics and quantities shown, making sure each row starts and ends with orange dot patches.




- **2 Note:** Refer to **Assembly Diagram** for following steps. Sew rows together, alternating with black solid 1" x 25½" strips.
- **3** Sew orange dot 21/4" x 34" strips to sides of quilt; trim even with top and bottom. Sew remaining orange dot 34" strips to top/bottom; trim even with sides.




Assembly Diagram



4 Follow manufacturer's instructions for paper-backed fusible web. Trace templates A-E on paper side of fusible web. Cut apart, leaving small margin beyond drawn lines. Fuse to wrong side of appropriate fabrics; cut out on drawn lines. Referring to Quilt Photo and Diagram II-A, arrange A-E in alphabetical order on quilt top. Fuse in place. Edge-stitch using machine blanket stitch and matching thread (Diagram II-B).

Machine blanket stitch



5 Layer, baste, and quilt. Bind with orange dot.


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That Cat
