Plan

Stylish prints combined in a sophisticated color scheme take this uncomplicated patchwork to elegant heights. Consider using a design wall or other flat surface to arrange your blocks and sashing strips before assembling your quilt. Use an accurate 1/4" seam allowance throughout to ensure all elements of the quilt fit together well; visit McCallsQuilting.com and click on Lessons, then How to Make a Quilt for a great tutorial.

Shop

Assorted turquoise, lime, teal, and olive prints (blocks, pieced sashing, 61/2-71/2 yds. pieced binding) total White solid (pieced sashing) 41/2 yds. Backing (piece widthwise) 87/8 yds. Batting size 102" x 114"

Cut



Assorted turquoise, lime, teal, and olive prints-cut a total of: 24 strips 21/2" x 20-22" (binding)


224 rectangles 41/2" x 61/2" 97 strips 1" x 41/2" White solid 42 strips 41/2" x 12" 98 rectangles 41/2" x 61/4" 12 rectangles 41/4" x 41/2"








Sew

1 Referring to **Diagram I**, stitch 4 assorted print 4½" x 6½" rectangles together to make a Four-Patch Block. Make 56 total.

2 Sew 2 white 4½" x 6¼" rectangles to assorted print 1" x 4½" strip to make pieced sashing strip (**Diagram II**). Make 49 total.





- **3 Note:** Refer to **Assembly Diagram** for this step. Stitch 7 block rows of 8 blocks and 7 pieced sashing strips each. Sew together 2 white 41/4" x 41/2" rectangles, 8 assorted print 1" x 41/2" strips, and 7 white 12" strips to make sashing row. Make 6. Sew rows together, alternating.
- 4 Layer, baste, and quilt.
- 5 Join assorted print 21/2" x 20-22" binding strips with diagonal seams (**Diagram III**). Bind with pieced strip.
